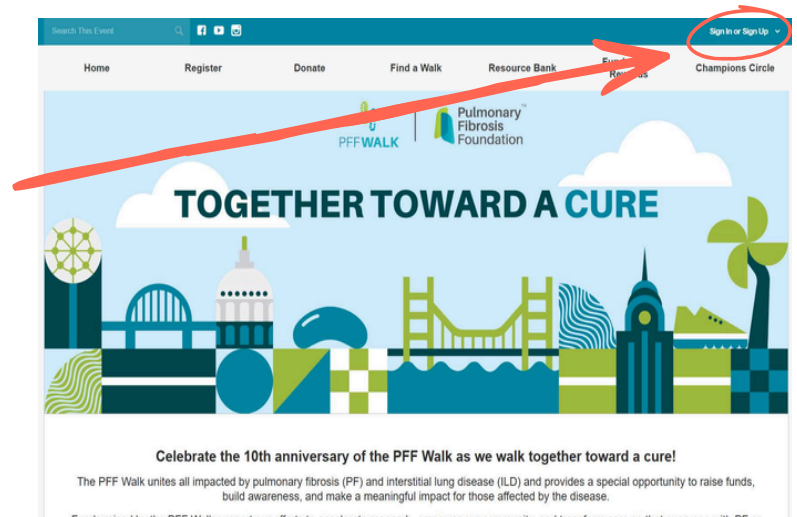


Fundraising Dashboard Guide

1 Accessing your Fundraising Dashboard

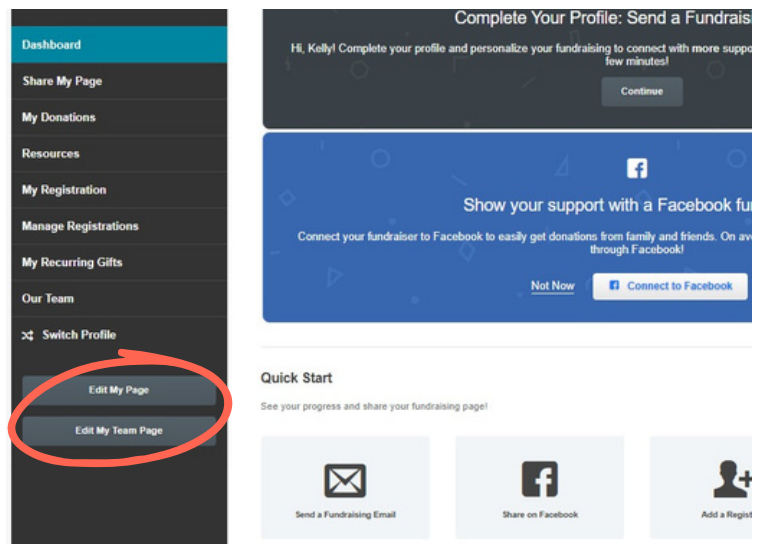

Click "Edit My Page" or "Edit My Team Page" to edit your profile photo, add photos to your fundraising page, and share your story.

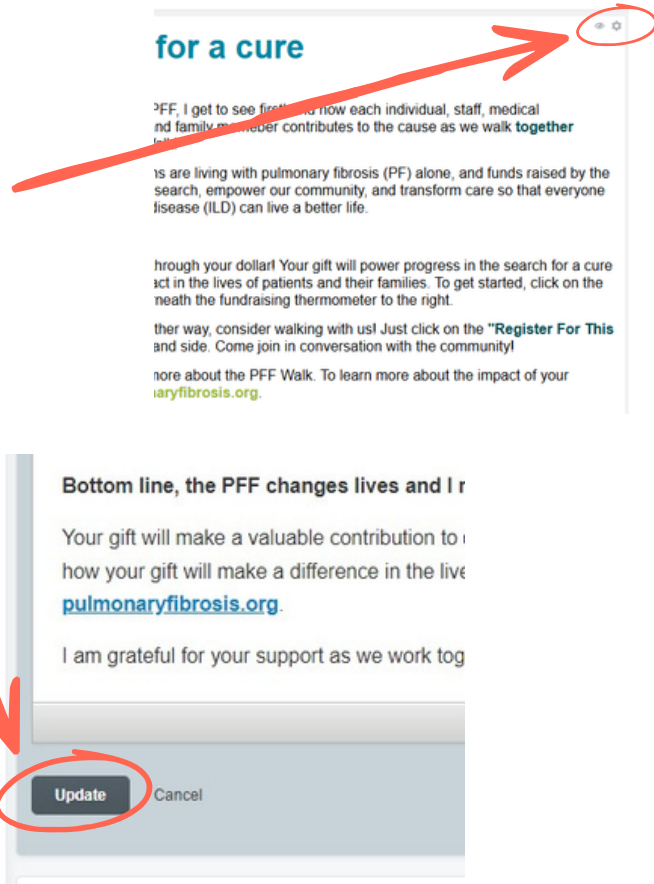

3 Editing your Personal or Team Message

Click on the wheel to open the editing screen and add your story to the message provided. Be sure to click "Update" once finished.

5 Navigating your Fundraising Dashboard

Share My Page: Email your donors, send a fundraising email, send emails to your team members, or share your fundraising page on Facebook and Twitter.

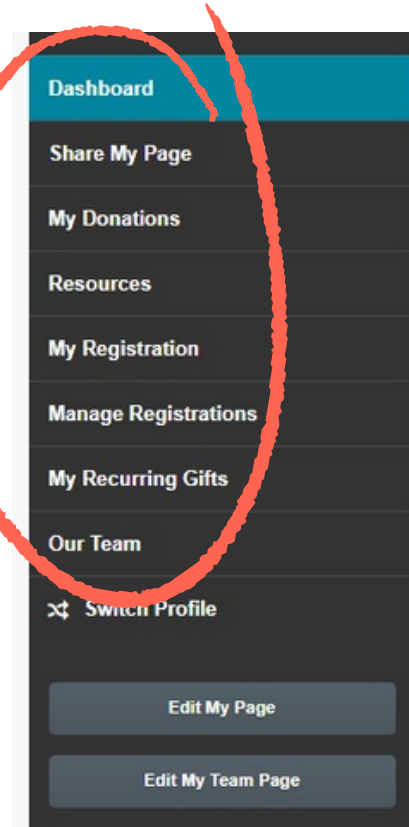
My Donations: View the donations you have received and update your goal.

Resources: Download resources such as Story Prompts, the Team Leader Guide, the Walker Guide, or the Who Do You Know exercise.

My Registration: Update your personal information and email permissions.

Manage Registrations: Add additional registrants such as children or other non-fundraising participants.

Our Team: Access team fundraising information and ask others to join your team.



6 Adding Additional Registrants

Click on "Manage Registrations" and then the "Add Additional Registrant" button to register other family members, children, or people without an email address as a non-fundraising participant.
