Registration

How do I register for the PFF Summit 2021? Conference registration can be found here: bit.ly/pffsummit2021

The virtual conference will officially launch on Monday, November 8th at 9:00am CST, and the first session will begin at 10:00 am CST.

How much does it cost to register for the PFF Summit 2021?

Note: Licensed community pulmonologists may also register to attend the Community Pulmonologist 2-day session at no cost. In order to have access to the full program, individuals must register in one of the other categories list above.

Do I have to register in order to attend the PFF Summit 2021? Yes, all attendees must be registered in order to attend Summit sessions and activities during the week of November 8, 2021. Registrants will have access to all sessions on-demand for three months following the conference.
